1. *What brought you to see Dr. Matt?*

I came to see Dr. Matt when my daughter was about 6 months old. I had always experienced lower back pain due to having differing leg lengths secondary to a femur leg break at age 5 that resulted in traction and a body cast, but it seemed to worsen after my C-section. I had also been experiencing severe and frequent headaches and shoulder pain.

2. *What treatment did you receive?*

Dr. Matt has been working with me for about 9 months, and over the course of that time my treatment has changed as my needs and physical situation have changed. Initially he was working on my neck and lower back as well as my shoulders. I was being adjusted 2-3 times per week, and after a period of 2 months was reduced to 1 time per week. It was around this time that I found out I was expecting again, and as a result my adjustments, and the way Dr. Matt worked with me and the frequency that he saw me for treatment were again modified.

3. *How did Chiropractic help you?*
